

Ministry Opportunities

Deacon-Led Ministry Teams (All the leaders of these teams are not deacons but are approved by the deacons to lead the team).

- **Church Ordinance Team (Baptism & Lord's Supper) – Jane Morgan**

This team will make the necessary preparations for the church to observe its ordinances; baptism and the Lord's Supper. These duties will include making sure we have current supplies of the necessary elements for the Lord's Supper, preparing them for a service and taking care of any cleanup that's involved. Also, they will make sure the baptistry is ready for baptism services, robes are ready, and any cleanup is conducted. This team will help any baptismal candidates with securing the right size robe, supplying towels, and making sure they are directed to a convenient place to change.

- **Buildings & Grounds Team – Charles McClellan/Tommy McDonald**

This team will provide general oversight for the building facilities and the grounds of the church property. They will monitor facilities to make sure everything is in order, lead the church to conduct needed work days, make sure problems are fixed, and make recommendations to the church for facility improvement.

- **HEART Team (Sick/Shut-In/Widows) – Steve Sprecher/Dave Snyder**

The HEART Team leader will make sure that every widow has been assigned a deacon and every single mother has been assigned a lady in the church. This team will monitor the needs of widows, shut-ins, and single parents and make sure that any reasonable needs are met. One immediate need in this ministry is to organize transportation for any residents of Wesley Meadows that want to attend our church.

- **Greeter/Usher – Sheila Poole**

This team will organize greeters for every service and activity of the church to ensure that people are greeted in a friendly manner by people who can provide necessary information and help with any needs attendees of our church may have. Also, this team will organize the usher ministry to ensure that the offering is collected in an orderly manner at every service where worship through giving is conducted. Ushers will also help attendees find necessary seating and take care of any other needs that people have in our facilities.

- **Kitchen Team – Jane Borgognoni**

This team does the preparation, cooking and dishwashing for our Wednesday evening meals. They may also help with special events when the need arises. This team is a great ministry that facilitates many church fellowship opportunities for the membership.

- **Security Team – Tom Cunningham**

This team will organize and provide a parking lot/security detail for Sunday mornings, evenings, Wednesday night, and any special events where security is needed.

- **Transportation Team – Duane Case**

This team is responsible for maintaining our fleet of vehicles.

- **Benevolence Team – Tommy Borgognoni**

This team will evaluate benevolence needs that our church becomes aware of and seek to meet those needs within the money available in the church budget. Also, this team will coordinate efforts to meet immediate, large scale needs like disaster relief.

- **Celebrate Recovery & The Landing - Don Scipper**

Volunteer to help serve in this ministry for people with hurts, habits and hang-ups. You can help in preparing meals or providing childcare. There are also opportunities to help Celebrate Recovery and the Landing meets on Friday nights from 6-8:30pm.

- **Fostering Hope - Jason Ford**

Serve fostering families by helping with monthly meals and childcare. Connect with fostering families to provide support through respite care, baby-sitting, supplies, etc. Fostering hope meets on the first Thursday of every month from 5:30-7pm.
